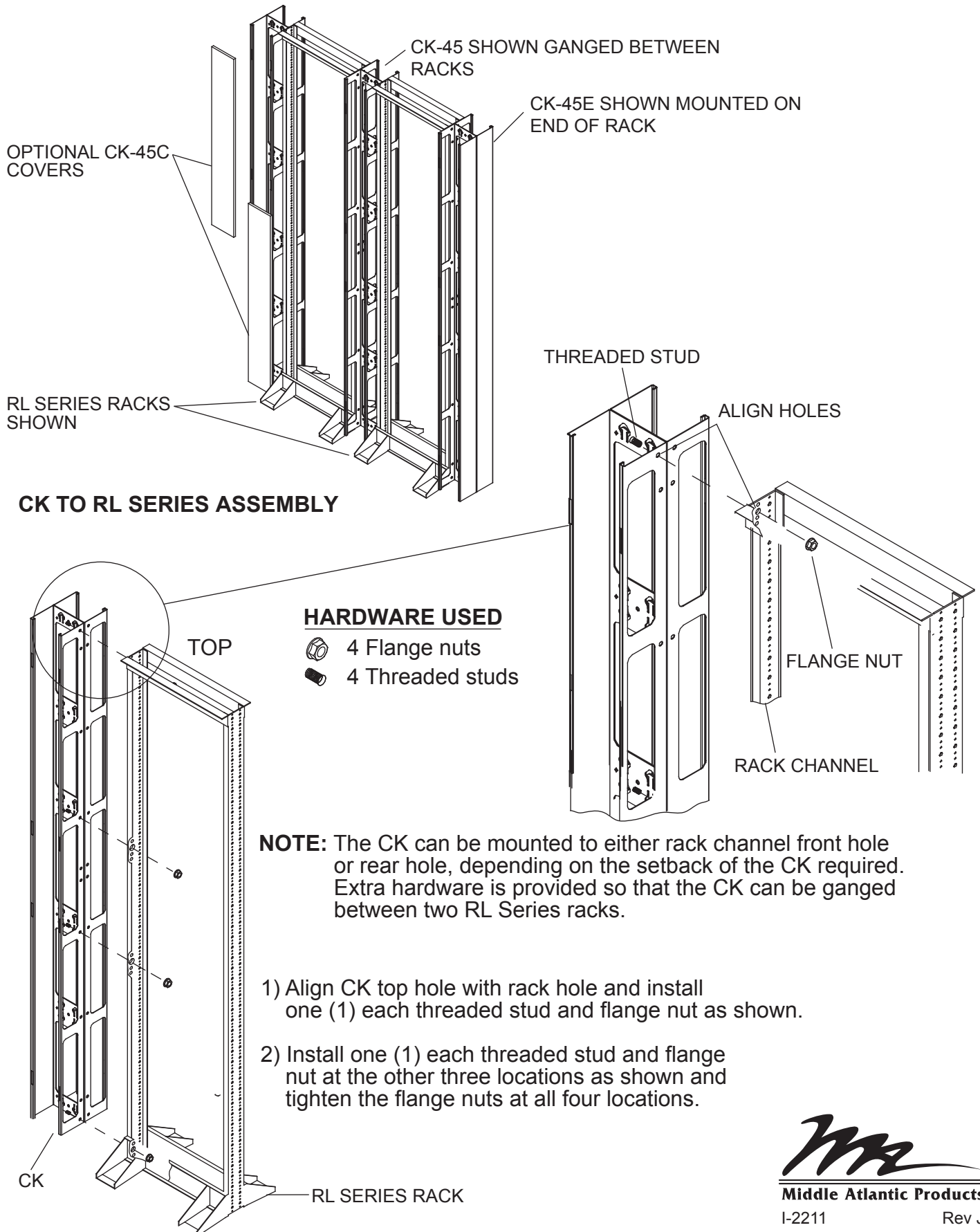

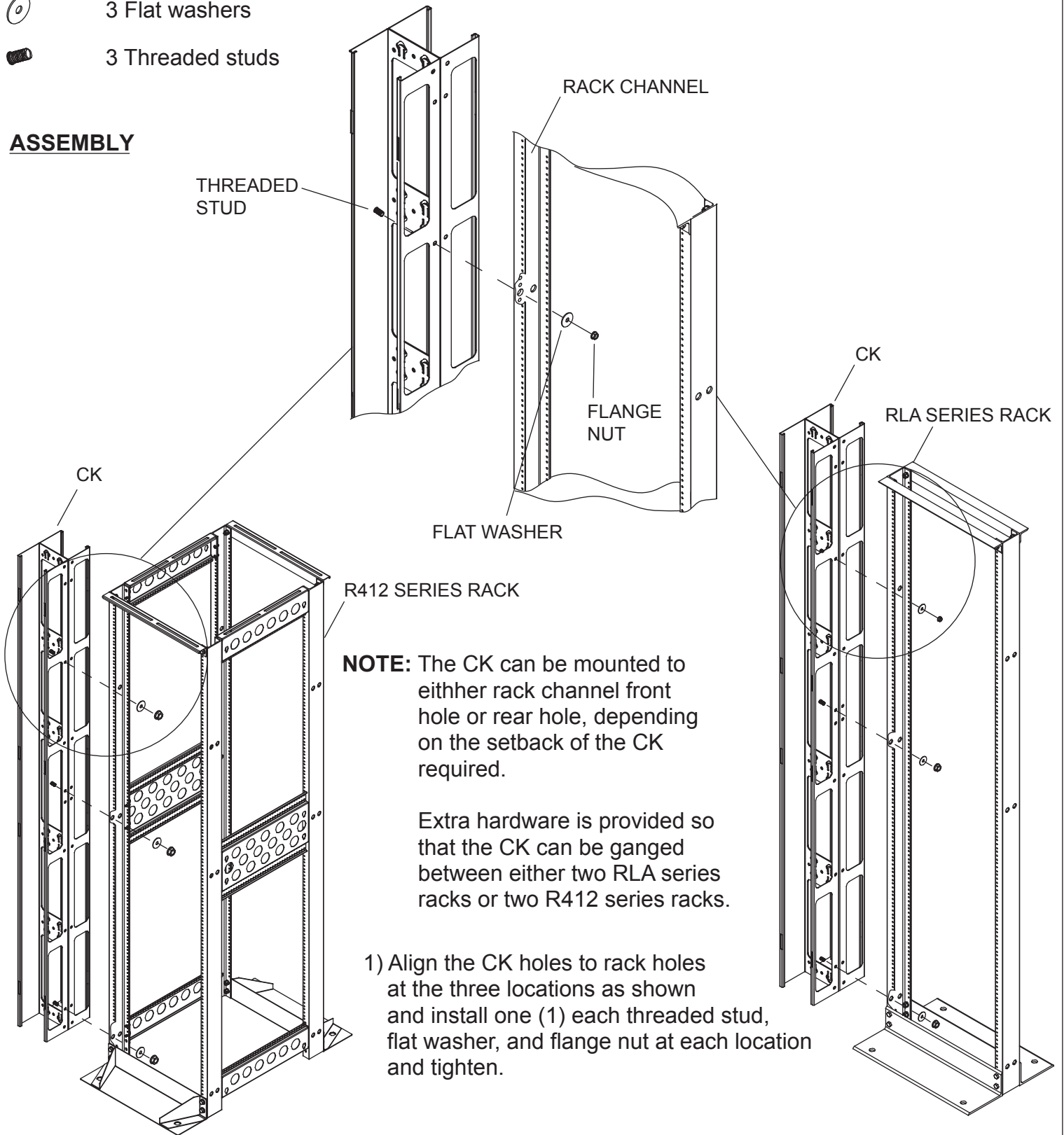

CK TO RLA SERIES AND R412 SERIES ASSEMBLY

-  3 Flange nuts
-  3 Flat washers
-  3 Threaded studs

CK TO R4CN SERIES ASSEMBLY

HARDWARE USED

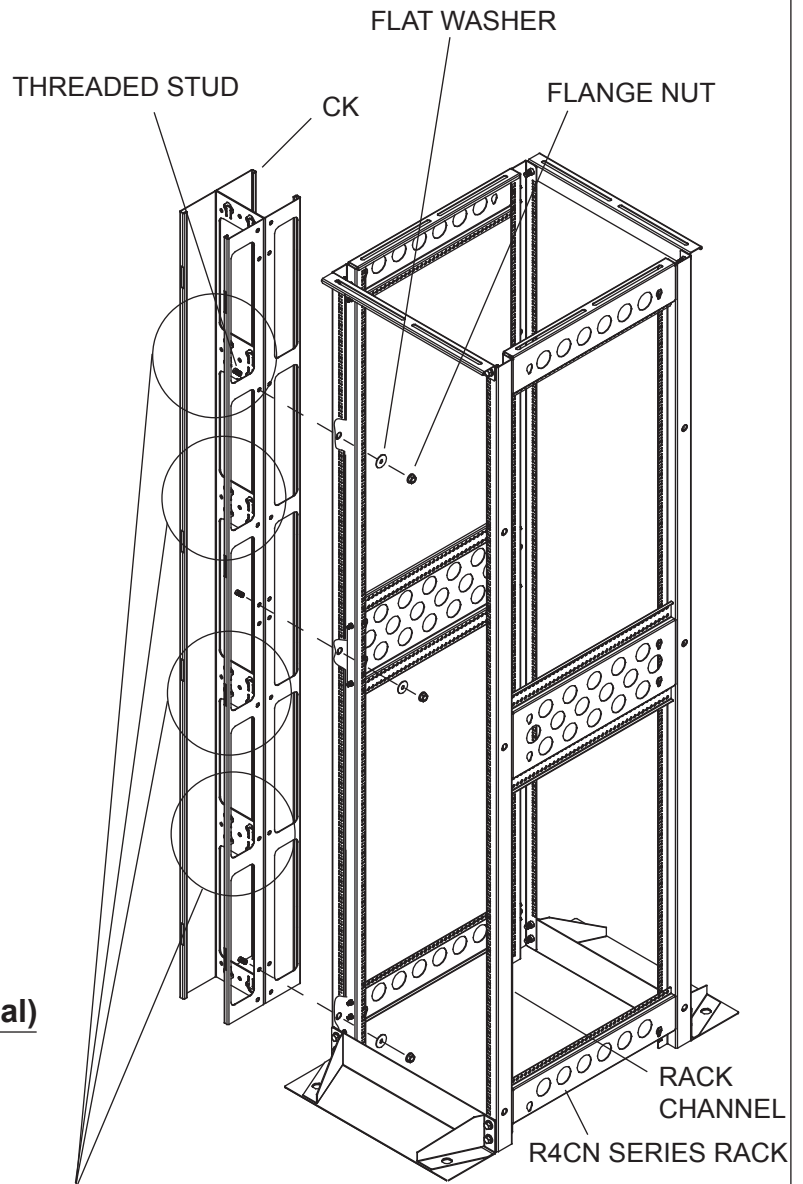
-  3 Flange nuts
-  3 Flat washers
-  3 Threaded studs

ASSEMBLY

NOTE: The CK can be mounted to any one of four rack channels.

Extra hardware is provided so that the CK can be ganged between two R4CN Series racks.

- 1) Align the CK holes to the rack holes at three locations as shown and install one (1) each threaded stud, flat washer, and flange nut at each location and tighten.



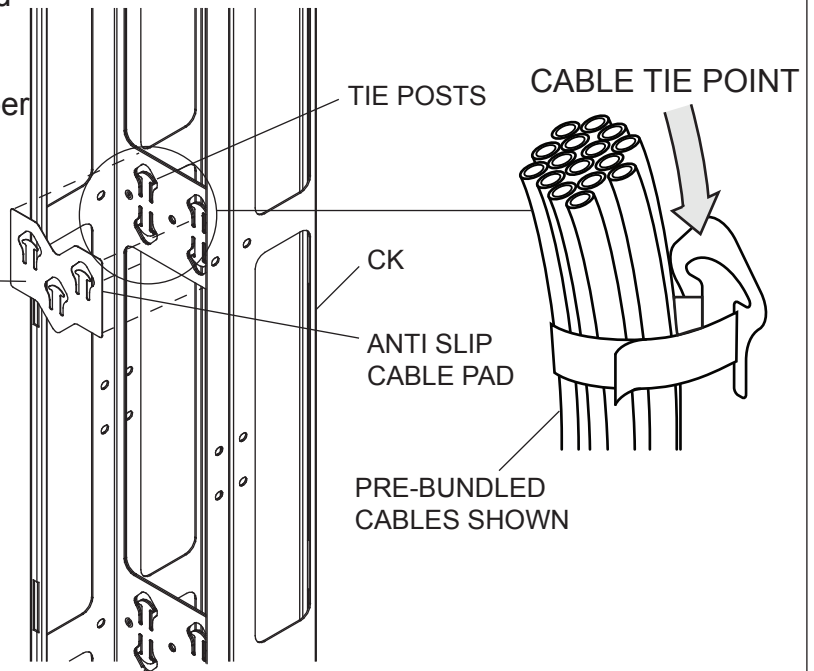
ANTI-SLIP CABLE PAD INSTALLATION (Optional)

ASP-OWP (4 piece Anti-Slip Cable Pad)
ASP-OWP-6 (24 piece Anti-Slip Cable Pad)

- 1) Determine location where cable will be secured to the CK tie posts.
- 2) Remove white backing from pad, align the upper two tie post patterns with the CK tie posts as shown, and place onto the tie posts.
- 3) Remove clear film and place cable against pad and secure as shown.

NOTE: The CK cable carrier tie posts accept cable ties and hook and loop straps for mounting of single and pre-bundles cables.

HEAVY CABLE BUNDLES ARE KEPT IN PLACE, REDUCING STRAIN ON CONNECTIONS AND TIE POINTS WITH THE ANTI-SLIP CABLE PAD'S PATENTED PERMANENT HIGH FRICTION SURFACE.
